Do you honor the invitation given to you?

Jesus compared the kingdom of heaven to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. When it was the day of the wedding feast none of the invited guest arrived. How could they refuse the graciousness of the king?

The kingdom of heaven and the wedding feast Jesus speaks about is within our midst, which is the celebration of the Holy Mass. Like the king who invited guests, Jesus is inviting us to be present at the Holy Mass, especially on Sundays.

Do we make time for Holy Mass? When going to a wedding, the invited guests prepare their most elegant clothes. Do we prepare ourselves before going to Holy Mass? Do we prepare ourselves with prior knowledge of the gospel and the other readings? In our gospel, the expected guests refused the invitation of the king,

which made him disheartened. The king then instructed his servants to go out again and invite anyone (bad and good alike). Many came to the wedding banquet and ate till their hearts content.

Perhaps many of us do not honor this invitation of Jesus to be present at Holy Mass. Why? Is it because we are also busy like the invited guest in the gospel? We are missing heaven on earth when we refuse to honor this invitation of Jesus. He gives us the opportunity to go to His wedding banquet, which is the celebration of Holy Mass.

Today let us pray for our brothers and sisters to be more conscious of the wonderful invitation God is giving us. Let us value it properly. As the gospel acclamation says, "*May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our hearts, so that we may know what is the hope that belongs to our call.*"

Do I strive to clothe myself with "*heartfelt mercy, kindness, humility, meekness and patience?*" How am I putting off the Lord's call to a deeper relationship with Him? What prevents me from putting off my own "*garments*" and put on Christ?
