#### 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time Mathew 10:37-42

A poor boy would frequently pass a store in his neighborhood and ask for food to bring home to feed his sick father. The store owner would always give the boy food. The store owner was kindhearted and was happy to help the boy and his father.

After the boy hadn't visited for awhile, the store owner wondered why the boy was not passing by his store anymore. He asked the people around the neighborhood about the boy and he was told that the boy's family had moved to the city to stay with a relative.

Twenty years had passed and the store owner was now old and sick and had to close the store. He had no one to tend to it anymore. One day a young, rich man was looking for the man who owned that store. The young man was brought to the former store owner.

He introduced himself to be the boy who would ask for food to bring to his sick father. The eyes of the sick man glowed and he asked: Why are you here? The rich man said: "I am here to give back your goodness." He took the sick man to the hospital and paid for all of his hospital bills. When he was discharged, he invited the old man to stay with him.

In the gospel for this Sunday, Jesus talks about giving back to those who do good for His followers. What does this mean? This simply means that whatever good that we do for those who follow Jesus we will receive blessings back a hundredfold.

Of course we all know that Jesus doesn't want us to limit our acts of goodness to His followers. Jesus wants us to do good for anyone who is in need. He wants us to do good for the poor loitering in the street, for the beggar asking for help, and for a relative who doesn't ask for help yet we know deep in our hearts that they are in need. We do good not because we want something in return. We do good because we want to obey Jesus.
